POSITION: Tenure-track, 9-month position as Assistant/Associate Professor in English Language Arts Education

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teach graduate and undergraduate courses in English Language Arts Education (including distance education courses); supervise internships and practica; advise graduate and undergraduate students; conduct and publish independent research; direct graduate students' research; develop proposals for extramural funding; take an active role in partnerships with school systems and academic life in the department.

The vision of Auburn University's Department of Curriculum and Teaching is to prepare teacher candidates and teachers to make reasoned decisions grounded in thoughtfully constructed values related to professional ethics, collaboration, diversity, and intellectual vitality. In addition, departmental faculty members envision teacher candidates and teachers who use reflective thinking as a tool of practice in their development as competent and committed professionals throughout their coursework and teaching career. Recognizing that technology permeates daily life and the classroom, faculty members envision teachers who possess the skills and abilities to incorporate a variety of technologies to manage, evaluate, and improve student learning.

QUALIFICATIONS: **Required:** An earned doctorate in English Language Arts Education or a closely related field with a minimum of 30 hours of graduate credit in English Language Arts Education is required. Eligible candidates must have evidence of at least three years of successful teaching experience in U.S. schools serving children grades 6-12. Excellent communication skills and proficiency in teaching with technology are also required.

Desired: Qualified candidates should provide evidence of superior teaching; demonstrated interest in teaching university methods courses; experience in supervising internships or clinical field experiences; experience teaching via distance technologies; an established record of or a strong potential for research and publication in refereed journals; involvement in writing and executing grants and funded projects; active membership in a professional organization such as NCTE; expertise in working with English language learners.

RANK/ SALARY: Assistant/Associate Professor (tenure track, nine-month contract) at a salary commensurate with experience and other qualifications. An ABD candidate may be appointed at the Instructor level for up to nine months until doctoral degree is completed.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Applicants must apply for the position electronically through <http://aufacultypositions.peopleadmin.com/postings/1008>. Send letter of application, vita, undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and three letters of recommendation. The candidate selected for this position must meet eligibility requirements to work in the U.S. when the appointment begins and for the proposed term of employment. Review of applications will begin June 15, 2015 and continue until the position is filled.
